1) The *Department of Education (DepED) Schools Division Office of the City of Ilagan*, through the GAA CY 2026 intends to apply the sum of **TWO MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED THIRTY FOUR THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED NINETY PESOS (Php 2,734,690.00)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for **PROCUREMENT OF SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM- NUTRITIOUS FOOD PRODUCTS FOR SY 2026-2027 (ENRICHED BREAD, NUTRICOOKIES & NUTRIBUN)** Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

- 3) The **Department of Education (DepED) Schools Division of the City of Ilagan**, now invites bids for **PROCUREMENT OF SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM-NUTRITIOUS FOOD PRODUCTS FOR SY 2026-2027 (Enriched Bread, Cookies & Nutribun)** Delivery of the Goods is **8 feeding days based on cycle menu**. Bidders should have completed, at least **5 years** from the date of submission and receipt of bids, contracts similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.
  - 4) Bidding will be conducted through competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the IRR of RA No. 12009.
    - i) Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.

- 5) Interested Bidders may obtain further information from **Department of Education (DepED) Schools Division of the City of Ilagan** and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from **Mondays to Fridays from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.**
- 6) A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on **June 30, 2026 to July 21, 2026** from the address given below upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of **Five Thousand Pesos Only (Php 5,000.00)**. The Procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees **in person, by facsimile, or through electronic means.**

- 8) Bids must be duly received by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) Secretariat through manual submission at the office address indicated below on or before **July 21, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. (PST). Late bids shall not be accepted.**
- 9) All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 16.1.
- 10) Bid opening shall be on **July 21, 2026 at 9:30 a.m. onwards** at the **SDO Board room, Second floor of the DepEd Schools Division of the City of Ilagan, City Civic Center, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela** and/or and/or via *online videoconferencing*. Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.
- 11) The **Department of Education (DepED) Schools Division of the City of Ilagan**, reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 70<sup>4</sup> of R.A. No. 12009, without incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders.
